








In the past, working uniforms at textile factories were gray-blue and poorly functional. Both men and women wear the same overalls

Reconstruct a workshop uniform and lift material





The shapes and texture on the uniform are all of rainbow stairs

- 1 There is a sleeve slit and a hook and loop fasteners to stick with one on the arm. The sleeves will not fall after they are rolled up, which can avoid getting wet the sleeves when workers wash things.
- 2 There are two pieces of water-absorbent fabric on the shoulders, which can wipe the sweat on their faces when the workers hands are not free, such as holding a lot of things on their hands
- 3 The chest pocket is made with a diagonal cut, making it easier to take out when square objects such as a mobile phone or licence are inside
- 4 The two pockets under the top are a diamond shape so its easily unzips from no matter which side. For example, something that requires is in the left pocket while left hand is working, the right hand can open the left pocket very quickly without having to bypass it.
- 5 There are also two water-absorbent fabrics at the back of the coat, which they can rub their hands when workers need to dry their hands immediately. 6 On the pants, each leg has two drawstring, which can be lifted up and fixed It can help workers to not wet their pants when wading through the water or washing things
