The Concept

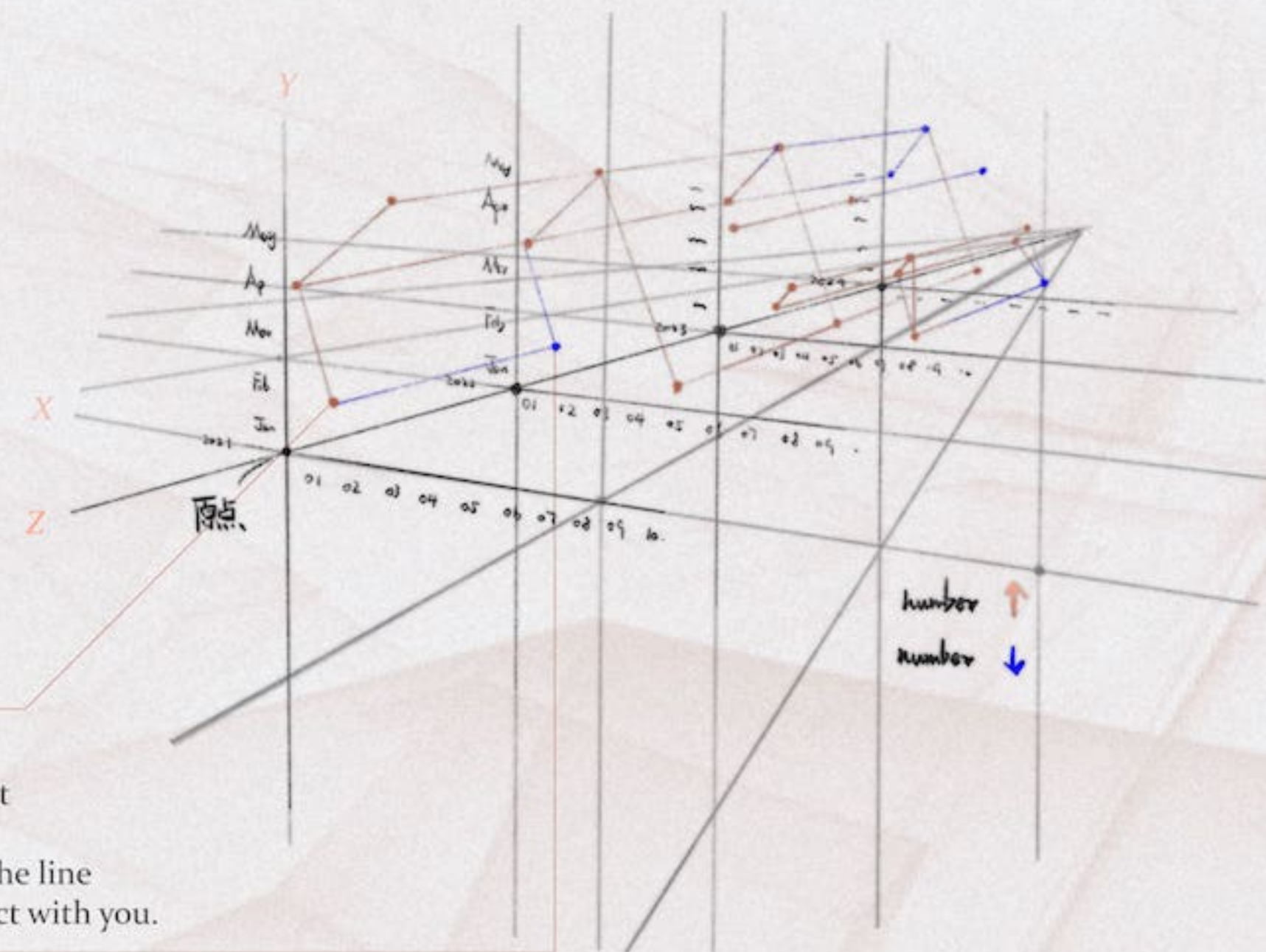
I think memory is the life of people.

Memories make up who we are (ego) and who we are in the eyes of others.

Now imagine this:

In an infinite space,
with the date as the x-axis,
the month as the y-axis,
and the year as the z-axis.

- ◆ Then locate each person we met on the corresponding date and extend them infinitely along the z-axis.
- ◆ On top of that, I think it is possible to connect the objects in your contacts that you know each other together, and also the color and transparency of the line will change with the frequency of contact with you.
