





I tied the hands of the two subjects with a rope, making it difficult for them to make a sign language dialogue. It is difficult for the signer to express himself

## **Photo experiment 4**


In this experiment, I was thinking about how to make photos communicate with each other in sign language, so I used the shooting technique of multiple exposure to overlap the words in one sign language sentence.






I finally applied the double exposure technique to the final photograph.


